After much discussion the town board has requested increased security whether it be volunteers or paid security that will be allowed to be decided by the event board. The town board has required that the names of the security staff be provided to the town board along with the permit application in 2020.

No report from the Manawa Fire Board as the meeting will be tomorrow—Sept. 17, 2019.

Don L. and Jeff H. shared information from the Bear Creek Fire Dept meeting. The main discussion was of the current equipment and what should be repaired vs replaced.

Nan has resigned as the town animal control officer. Jeff Handschke will speak to Malcome Hathorne to see if he would consider the position.

Don Laughlin and Al Tank will work on the WISLR Road Certification Packet to ensure that the report is submitted by the due date.

The Budget Workshop will be on Thursday, October 17, 2019 at 6:30PM with the Budget Public Hearing on November 18, 2019.

The quarterly newsletter will be published. Items to be sure to include are reminders of not to push snow across the road, tax collection dates, and that storm cleanup is the responsibility of the land owner and if the town needs to clean up we do have the right to charge the cost to the land owner. We will hire Doug Casey to do the push backs.

WTA State Conference will be in October at WI Dells. Chairman Al and Clerk Mary Schoenrock will be attending.

Star Communications—installation is scheduled for Friday, September 20, 2019.

Tank Rd update was discussed. The major issue is the position of a power pole that prohibits standard road right of way. It is possible if curb was installed vs. shoulder that there would be enough room. Al will talk with Les Prochnow about this. After discussion on the delay of the county doing the engineering on Stage Rd the board instructed Al to obtain estimates from other engineering firms and timelines to see if it can be done sooner

Discussion was held and decision was made to continue to contact Attorney Carlson when legal assistance is needed.
