

April 20, 2021 Town of Lebanon Annual Meeting Minutes

Meeting was called to order by Al Tank at 7:30PM. There were 11 residents in attendance.

Minutes from September 2020 Annual meeting were read. Motion made by Connie Laughlin, 2nd by Bernie Ritchie to approve minutes as read. Motion carried.

Financial report was provided. Motion made by Bill Kuehl, 2nd by Connie Laughlin to accept report as presented. Motion carried.

Al Tank reported that a new town hall sign is being planned. Also that a large screen TV and touchless soap dispensers were purchased using grant money we received due to Covid19. He also reported that the big town plow truck is showing its age and the board members will be looking for replacement(s). Also reported that there are no big road projects planned for this year.

A suggestion to reduce speed on Church Rd. to 35 MPH. DOT has specs that need to be met to allow that and we are not sure if Church Rd. will qualify. Harry Blum stated the traffic on Church Rd. does not travel posted 45 MPH. Drivers entering onto Church Rd. from Fairway Dr. do not stop completely. Residents also commented that traffic on Madden Rd. do not travel at the posted 45MPH. Residents would like to see a traffic study done to see what options there are such as reducing the speed to 35MPH on Church Rd. from Buelow Rd. to Highway 45.

Al Tank reported that the broadband tower will be erected in the next few months. Details of contract are being worked on.

Connie Laughlin suggested that annual meeting start at 7:00PM.

Motion made by Bill Kuehl to donate \$500.00 to each of the cemeteries (Emanuel Cemetery, Ruckdashel Cemetery, St. Patrick's Cemetery) located in the Town of Lebanon. Motion 2nd by Lynn Tank. Motion carried

Bernie Ritchie reported on County projects completed and planned for the upcoming year. The county plans to do various road projects throughout the county and that 17.3 miles of road projects will be completed this year.

Motion made by Bernie Ritchie 2nd by Connie Laughlin to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 7:54PM.
