Emergency Board Meeting Minutes –October 26, 2023

Meeting called to order by Chairman Al Tank at 6:00PM.

Roll call by Clerk Schoenrock. Present: Al Tank, Don Laughlin Randy Schoenrock, Mary Schoenrock, Cody Gorges and Craig Schuh from Ayres Associates were present virtually.

Motion made by Don Laughlin, 2nd by Randy Schoenrock to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

Cody Gorges stated that a discussion was held with Tyler from NE Asphalt about the delays on the Church Rd project due to rain and now the forecast shows cold weather. If the ambient air is less than 40 degrees then an additive needs to be added to the asphalt to keep it pliable. The cost for this additive is \$2.80/ton. Tyler Heiman also is concerned about the hill as it is “slimy” from all the rain. The recommendation is that some stone be removed, and new stone be put in. The Town Board members discussed that their preference would be to wait 1-2 days on the hill but realize NE predicament that waiting would cause. The consensus of the board members was that if stone is removed that it be stockpiled at town hall, and we would pay for new stone but no labor/trucking costs. The board also stated that the additive be used only when absolutely necessary and to hopefully reduce the price. Cody, Al, and Don will meet with Tyler on the hill on 10/27/23 to discuss these options.

Al Tank presented the cost for the road surface markings on Church Rd from both Waupaca County and NE Asphalt. After discussion motion was made by Randy Schoenrock, 2nd by Don Laughlin to hire Waupaca County to do the striping on the hill area on Church Rd. Discussion of the motion was held and it was determined that the old striping went past the intersection of Church Rd and Buelow Rd and ended by the first residence. Motion was amended to extend the striping to the first residence west of Buelow Rd. Motion carried.

Motion made by Don Laughlin, 2nd by Randy Schoenrock to approve all bills as presented. Motion carried.

Motion made by Randy Schoenrock, 2nd by Don Laughlin to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:45PM.
